#### *Child Development - Bachelor of Science*

This program combines a basic education in human ecology and a broad general education with preprofessional preparation related to employment in early childhood education centers, Headstart, kindergartens, and early elementary grades in schools. It is especially appropriate for the student interested in working with children of pre-primary and early elementary ages.

To meet the Michigan State Board of Education standard, students in the Bachelor of Science degree program with a major in child development are required to satisfy the State of Michigan requirements for a teaching major in language arts or social studies; those requirements are included in the requirements for the concentration in language arts or social studies. Students who complete the requirements for the concentration are not required to complete an approved disciplinary minor for teacher certification.

#### **Requirements for the Bachelor of Science Degree in Child Development**

1. The University requirements for bachelor's degrees as described in the *Undergraduate Education* section of this catalog; 120 credits, including general elective credits, are required for the Bachelor of Science degree in Child Development.

The completion of an Writing, Rhetoric and American Cultures writing course referenced in item 3. c. (1) below may also satisfy the University's Tier I writing requirement.

The completion of Mathematics 201 referenced in item 3. a. below may also satisfy the University mathematics requirement.

The University's Tier II writing requirement for the Child Development major is met by completing Human Development and Family Studies 321. This course is referenced in item 3. a. below.
