History has consulted both internally and with the other units whose courses are on the current menu of courses for the program (Arts and Letters, English, IAH, Music, and WRA), and the only solution seems to be to place the specialization into moratorium while we decide (1) whether we wish to continue to offer the specialization and (2), if so, whether appropriate courses exist to enable us to continue to offer a coherent, viable program.</p> <p>Moratorium Extended: Reason for Moratorium Extension: Continuing discussion of a broader minor to replace the specialization.
